The South West Yorkshire Shire Horse Hiring Society Foal 6 Star Accumulator.

Open to Pure Bred Shire Horse Foals born in 2024

Honley Show is once again participating in this Accumulator. Points will be awarded for Shire Foal classes at the following shows:- Harthill Carnival, Emley, Arthington, Honley, Halifax, and the South West Yorkshire Shire Horse Hiring Society in association with Penistone Show.

Points as follows : 1st 5pts, 2nd 4pts, 3rd 3 pts, 4th 4pts, 5th 1 pt will be awarded according to the placings of the Foal classes.

This competition is open to everyone; membership of any of the Show Societies is not required.

The Foal with the most points at the end of the 6 shows will receive **£100**, kindly donated by **SWYSHHS**, and be named South West Yorkshire Champion.

The Reserve Champion will receive £50, kindly donated by **Messrs R&R Bedford of Hartcliff Shires.**

NB. in order to be eligible to win the accumulator, the foal must compete at the final Show of the series held at the Penistone Agricultural Show, where the presentation to the Champion and Reserve Champion will take place.

Important information re. EQUINE INFLUENZA

Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements of the primary course (1st vaccination & then 2nd vaccination between 21 – 92 days later) followed by the first booster (150 - 215days) and then all subsequent boosters. Horses may compete having received the primary course and prior to the first booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose.

Horses must have been vaccinated within 6 months before the Show but not less than 7 days of arriving at the Show.

Foals

In-foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary course Equine Influenza should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born.

Foals should be vaccinated for Equine influenza at 6 months to commence their primary course.

All owners are urged to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times.

Vaccinations are subject to local risk assessments by the attending veterinarians.

Monitoring of Compliance

PLEASE NOTE THAT NEITHER VACCINATION CERTIFICATES NOR PASSPORTS SHOULD BE SENT TO THE SHOW PRIOR TO THE EVENT. HOWEVER RANDOM CHECKS WILL BE CARRIED OUT ON THE SHOWGROUND DURING THE SHOW.

Entry Fee: £8.00 all classes. On the Day Entries £10.

Postal Entries Close: 26th June 2024 to allow for the entries to be received by the Heavy Horse Secretary.

(Late entries taken on Day of Show at the Horse Secretary's Tent up to 12.00 am)

Tickets will be required to access the main showfield. These can be obtained from the Secretary.

Shire Horse Classes

Judge: Mr Anson Franklin, Borseley, Macclesfield, Cheshire.

Judging: To commence in either Ring 1 or 2 at approx 2pm.

Class 1 – Barren Mare or Gelding – 3 years old and over

Class 2 – Colt, Gelding or Filly born 2023 (Yearling)

Class 3 – Gelding or Filly born 2022 (2 years old)

Class 4 – Brood Mare with Foal at foot

Class 5 – Foal Born 2024

Class 6 – Young Handlers: Age 12-18 years. Winner qualifies for Young Handler of the Year 2024 at the Midland Shire Foal Show.

Class 7 – Ridden Heavy Horse or Cross (Shire or Clydesdale). Shire and Shire cross to be judged in line with SHS Criteria.

Class 8 – Any other recognized heavy horse breed (in-hand)
