# **Parking**

HORSE BOXES WILL BE ALLOWED ACCESS ONTO THE SHOW GROUND FROM 7am.

ALL box drivers are obliged to co-operate with the parking stewards.

The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to those who do not co-operate.

# **Vaccinations**

ALL EQUINES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PASSPORT.

RANDOM CHECKS WILL BE CARRIED OUT ON THE SHOWGROUND DURING ENTRY.

Please make sure you have your passport ready.

EQUINE FLU - All equines attending Honley Agricultural Show must have been vaccinated for Equine Influenza within the past 12 months.

The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows:

First 2 vaccinations 21 - 60 days apart;

Third booster between 120-180 days;

Annual booster vaccination within 6 months or 12 months depending on governing body.

No horse/pony should enter competitions within 7 days of an El vaccination

No equine should enter competitions within 7 days of an El vaccination

Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old.

All owners are urged to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times.



## Rules

# ALL EXHIBITORS MUST HAVE PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

Hard hats that conform to current BHS regulations must be worn by all riders within the showground when mounted.

All stallions must be shown correctly bitted.

Children under 14 years old may not show colts (with the exception of foals) or stallions in In-Hand classes.

Children under 12 years old may not show Stallions in Ridden Classes.

ALL RIDERS/ HANDLERS MUST DISPLAY THEIR ANIMAL'S COMPETITOR NUMBER AT ALL TIMES WHEN EITHER RIDING OR LEADING THEIR ANIMAL ANYWHERE ON THE SHOWGROUND.

Whiskers/Sensory Hairs

All equines should present with no evidence of whiskers or sensory hairs having been trimmed or removed (other than for veterinary purposes, in which case you must provide written proof from your Vet; this proof must be available at the Show if requested by a Show Official). Sensory hairs are the hard hairs located on the horse's muzzle and around the eyes, also known as 'whiskers' that are used for sensation. Any competitor in breach of this will be disqualified.

Class 55. Stallions and Geldings. 4years old and over. Best Gelding Rosette.

**Class 56.** Mare 4 years old and over or Brood mare 5 years old and over with own foal at foot. Foals to be 6 weeks old or over at date of show. Foals to be judged first. *Best Foal Rosette*.

Class 57. Young stock. Colt, Filly or Gelding 3 years old and under.

Best 2 year old.

4 years and over. Minimum age for the rider 3 years. Children of 8 years old or under may be led. When a child competes on a lead rein the donkey must be led by a competent adult (18 years or over) and the leading rein must be attached to the noseband.

**Please Note:** Entering one donkey and showing another is not permitted. Stallions and Entire Colts must be properly dressed in bridle and bit with the leading rein correctly attached to the bit. In the 'Mare with Foal at Foot' class, superficial blemishes do not necessarily debar a mare from being awarded a prize.

**Definitions:** Donkey classes are open to all donkeys and all exhibitors, whether they are members of the Donkey Breed Society or not. Donkey Breed Society Rosettes may only be awarded to Donkey Breed Society Members.

The In Hand Champion Donkey at this show automatically qualifies for the relevant Championship at the DBS Annual Supreme Championship Show in August 2024, Provided it is owned by a fully paid up member of the DBS. A Donkey may win more than one Championship at shows but will qualify only once for the DBS Supreme Championship Show. Where the In Hand Champion Donkey has previously qualified, the Reserve Champion Donkey will be deemed the Qualifier.
