Show Catalogue

Show Catalogues will be available on request after the judging is complete. Alternatively, sign up to the [mailing list](#) to receive a digital version automatically.

Digital catalogues will identify all exhibits, the prizes awarded and the named judges

Biosecurity recommendations for all exhibitors:

- 1) All birds should be health-checked before travelling to any gathering.
- 2) All birds travelling from a gathering to any premises must be isolated from other birds at that premises and health-monitored for at least 7 days afterwards.
- 3) The keeper of any birds attending a gathering should be registered with the Animal and Plant Health Agency on the GB Poultry Register.

Biosecurity measures at the show:

- 1) Disinfectant mats will be used at Poultry tent entrances.
- 2) All birds will be inspected on arrival by a Welfare Officer. No birds will be admitted to the Poultry tent until after inspection.
- 3) Poultry will be refused entry if the travel container for poultry is visibly contaminated with bird droppings or other material of bird origin, other than faeces produced during the transportation of the birds to the show.
- 4) A veterinary surgeon will be available for any birds that show signs of ill-health or welfare problems.

Parking

Limited parking next to the poultry tent will be available for poultry exhibitors.

Parking permits and directions will be provided after the closing date
